For Entering Freshmen

Students entering Bryn Mawr may transfer up to four units of credit from college work done during high school, including courses taken at community colleges or two-year colleges.

Courses must have been regular college classes taken with other college students. College courses taught at the high school, and courses for high school students taught at the college or university do not qualify for transfer credit.

Credit will be given only for those community college courses taken before the student was admitted to Bryn Mawr.

IS 101 - Introductory Seminar Int'l Studies
(4 credits) This course enables students to become knowledgeable in global interrelations among nations, non-state actors, and peoples from a multidisciplinary perspective. The focus is on two of the leading issues of the modern world: relations among different cultures and globalization.
Minimum Grade:

GST 110 - Introduction to Global Studies
This course focuses on the international processes, issues, and topics that are key to understanding globalization. This course will formally employ perspectives and concepts from three disciplines: political science, economics, and sociology. However, this course will also draw upon a number of other disciplines: culture and language, history and geography ("time and space"), as well as philosophy. This course will also have a strong multicultural content with an emphasis on how values impact a range of policy issues: trade, money, development, population, hunger, overpopulation, climate change, culture, environment, democracy, and security.


